

About the Agreement

In 2014, the Edwards School of Business at the University of Saskatchewan and the Saskatchewan Indian Institute of Technologies (SIIT) signed a transfer agreement that will enable more Aboriginal students to attain university business degrees.

Graduates of SIIT's one-year Business Certificate program or two-year Business Diploma program will qualify to transfer either one or two years towards the four-year Bachelor of Commerce degree offered through the Edwards School of Business.

Edwards will allow students to transfer up to 60 credit units (out of 120) of transferable courses from another institution.

All applicants to Edwards will follow the U of S transfer student admissions process. The annual admission deadline is **FEBRUARY 15**. All applicants must ensure that original transcripts are sent directly from SIIT to the U of S Transfer Credit Office. For further information and to apply please visit www.explore.usask.ca.

SIIT students who completed the Business Certificate program (which is no longer offered) will receive transfer credit for **1 year** based on the core classes listed on this page.
